

LUNDENWIC: SAXON LONDON'S DARK LANDS

Especially in support of the "Anglo Saxons and Scots in Britain" study unit in the National Curriculum in History. Also supports literacy, music and drama.

Set in the time of the Anglo Saxon Chronicle, when Roman London was still occupied by the "Boc Laeden" who are trying to preserve the old way of life, while the present-day Covent Garden is occupied by newcomers from across the North Sea.

Children become Saxon Londoners - some from each side of the English/British divide - and take an active part in this unique form of interactive Theatre in Education, encountering some of the characters and dilemmas of the time.

The day takes place in and around the historic church of All Hallows by the Tower, founded at the time of the action of the play.

A practical workshop will enable participants to discover something of the poetry and music of the time, as they compose their own poem in the style of "Beowulf" and learn to write in runes.

A comprehensive teachers' resource book will provide historical background material and suggestions for preparatory and follow-up work.


